

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SELECTING COURSES FOR 2010-2011

This year at Woburn C.I., in order to be environmentally conscious, information needed for course selection will be available online at www.woburnci.com. Students and parents can and **SHOULD** consult with teachers and guidance counsellors to help make informed decisions.

STEPS TO FOLLOW:

1. Read all of the following instructions carefully.
2. Print the “Course Selection Sheet” so that you can record the courses you wish to take in 2010-2011. **Bring the completed course selection sheet** to your home form class on **Feb. 11** prior to Bubble day.
3. Consult the grade appropriate “Supplement” for details – fees, prerequisites, levels, etc.
4. Use the link to “Course Descriptions” or go to www.tdsb.on.ca – “Programs” – “Curriculum Areas of Study” to find out more about the courses you are interested in.
5. Consult the diploma requirements found in your agenda, on this website, or in “Choices”
6. Consult the Guidance counsellors, your teachers and parents.
7. Attend the **“Option Information Day” on Tues. Feb. 9th** at 10:05am (delayed start). (Be prepared to ask questions about any courses you are interested in but need more information)
8. Choose your courses wisely.
9. Record the courses you want to take next year on the “Course Selection Sheet”
If a student has less than 16 credits they must take 8 courses.
If a student has 16 credits s/he can take 7 courses.
If a student has 24 credits s/he can take 6 courses.
It is recommended that students take 7 or 8 courses.
10. All students **must provide 2 alternate courses** that may be used in the event of timetabling issues.
DO NOT PUT THE ALTERNATE CHOICES ON YOUR BUBBLE SHEET ON FEB. 17TH!!!!!!
11. Bring the **COMPLETED** “Course selection Sheet” to your home form on Feb. 11th so that you can transfer your selected courses onto the scantron sheet.
12. **ALL STUDENTS** must fill in a scantron sheet on **BUBBLE DAY – WED. FEB. 17TH**
Students **not returning** to Woburn must fill the circles beside **NOTRET**
13. Math codes: **FUNCAL** is the code for the **semestered** math – Advanced Functions & Calculus and Vectors.
MHF4U2 is the code for the **non-semestered** math – Advanced Functions
14. Students may take only **ONE** Interdisciplinary studies course , choose between:
IDC4U1 or FINSEC or SCIALL.
